

At a duly called meeting of the Legislative Council on January 4, 2021, the Council voted to implement the following COVID protocol for the Alabama State House:

- (1). All employees and visitors entering the State House shall be subjected to a COVID screening. The screening should cover known risk factors, symptoms, and thermal temperature scanning. Any employee or visitor deemed to be an infection risk or any person who has a temperature that exceeds the current guidance provided by the Alabama Department of Public Health shall be denied entrance to the building.
- (2). Persons in the State House shall wear masks, consistent with the guidance and exceptions articulated by the CDC or Alabama Department of Public Health, in all common spaces of the building and around other persons.
- (3). The Secretary of the Council shall coordinate with the Secretary of the Senate and Clerk of the House to provide appropriate signage of this policy at all public entrances.
- (4). The Council requests the House and Senate to adopt rules for its membership consistent with this policy.
