(a) As used in this section, "nonprofit 15 veterans' organization" means any nonprofit organization that has a tax-exempt status under 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3) and, as 16 17 its primary purpose, supports veterans and active duty 18 servicemembers, as defined pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 3911, and 19 their dependents. 20 (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, when a 21 nonprofit veterans' organization, by means of a reversionary 22 clause in a deed, acquires a possessory interest in a state 23 armory building, with the intent to use the facility to 24 further the organization's support of veterans, active duty 25 servicemembers, and their dependents, the building shall be deemed to be in exempt from compliance with any applicable 26 state or local building codes for not less than 10 calendar 27

years from the date of acquisition.
