L 9	structure, that will not be placed in a state of active
20	operation or that will not be utilized by the homeowner at the
21	time of the residential structure's completion. The term only
22	includes features that do not contribute to the life safety or
23	structural aspects of the building code being enforced.
24	(2) RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE. A residence on a single lot,
25	including a site-built home, a condominium, duplex, apartment,
26	or any other single-unit or multi-unit residential building.
27	(b) The governing body of any municipality or county,
28	or any agency thereof, may not directly or indirectly adopt or



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enforce any ordinance, rule, bylaw, order, or state or local
building code provision requiring the installation of any
latent feature in any residential structure.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
day of the third month following its passage and approval by
the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
