16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
17	Section 1. For the purpose of maintaining order and
18	avoiding the disruption in the provision of law enforcement
19	services and the operation of the county jail, the highest
20	ranking deputy sheriff in the office of the sheriff shall
21	discharge the duties of the sheriff when any of the following
22	apply:
23	(1) When the office of the sheriff is vacant and until
24	a successor is qualified.
25	(2) When the sheriff is incompetent to act.
26	(3) When the sheriff is imprisoned.
27	(4) In any <del>civil or</del> criminal proceeding <mark>involving the</mark>
28	discharge of the duties of the office of the sheriff in which



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29	the sheriff is a party.
30	(5) In any case when directed by the judge of probate.
31	Section 2. Section Sections 11-5-5, 11-5-6, 11-5-7,
32	11-5-8, and $11-5-9$ of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to
33	the county coroner serving as sheriff under certain
34	conditions, are repealed.
35	Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first
36	day of the third month following its passage and approval by
37	the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
