Senate Bill 157 as passed the Senate would increase the obligations of the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA) by an agency-estimated amount of \$50,000 to develop and install updates to the Law Enforcement Tactical System to receive the conditions of parole and probation for parolees and probationers, as reported by the Board of Pardons and Paroles and sentencing courts as required by the provisions of this bill.

In addition, this bill could increase the administrative obligations of law enforcement agencies to notify the Board of Pardons and Paroles within 24-hours of an arrest of a parolee or probationer.

Further this bill could increase the obligations of the Board, by an estimated \$3.50 per day, for each parolee that is arrested for a new offense and requires electronic monitoring per the provisions of this bill.
