House Bill 353 as reported by the Committee on Boards, Agencies and Commissions could decrease the obligations of the State Board of Genetic Counseling by an estimated \$1,000 per meeting by allowing the 9-member board to meet electronically. Further, this bill would allow the Board to make grants from the Genetic Counseling Fund to qualified individuals, institutes, or agencies to develop and promote genetic counseling and continuing education programs for licensees.
