House Bill 260 as reported by the Committee on Boards, Agencies and Commissions: (1) codifies the current practice of the Alabama Electronic Security Board of Licensure to provide for the requirements of a Qualifying Agent licensee and the process for disciplinary actions; (2) require a licensee to advertise under the name in which licensed; (3) allow the Board to immediately impose a penalty on an individual or business that has not renewed their license; (4) increase the penalty to an injunction action from up to \$1,000 to up to \$5,000; (5) allow the Board to file a civil action to collect an awarded judgment; and (6) formalize the collection of administrative fines and of the handling of complaints made to the Board. This could increase receipts to the Board's fund by an undetermined amount dependent upon the amount of imposed fines and court judgments collected.
