Senate Bill 72 as reported by the Committee on Transportation and Energy, beginning July 1, 2023, would allow a judge to order a person charged with driving under the influence and who participates in a pretrial diversion program or similar program to install an ignition interlock device. This could impact receipts deposited to the various funds that the ignition interlock fee is distributed to, by an undetermined amount dependent upon the difference in (1) the number of individuals required to install an ignition interlock device pursuant to Act 2018-517 (which is set to expire on July 1, 2023); and (2) the number of individuals ordered to install an ignition interlock device based upon a finding of a judge.
