Senate Bill 153 as passed the Senate could increase the obligations of the Board of Pardons and Paroles by an undetermined amount dependent upon the number of defendants charged with Class A or Class B violent felony offenses and ordered to be supervised and the type of supervision utilized to comply with the provisions of this bill. According to the Administrative Office of Courts, the number of Class A and Class B violent felony offenses filed in fiscal years 2021 and 2022 were 24,576 and 24,324, respectively.
