Senate Bill 1 as passed the Senate would revise the rate at which an inmate may accrue correctional incentive time; (2) increases the time period that an inmate must be in certain classifications before moving to a different classification; and (3) provide additional violations that would result in forfeiture of correctional incentive time. These provisions could result in a prisoner serving a longer period of confinement in a local or state correctional facility than otherwise provided by current law. The Department of Corrections (DOC) estimates the cost of housing an inmate at approximately \$80 per day.

Further, this bill would increase the administrative obligations of DOC to submit annual reports to the Legislature, Governor, and Attorney General relating to correctional incentive time.
