Senate Bill 5 as reported by the Committee on Ways and Means General Fund would (1) increase the minimum number of residential transition centers that the Board of Pardons and Paroles may establish and maintain from one or more, under current law, to two or more; and (2) require the board to designate one residential transition center as a women's facility. This bill would increase the obligations of the board by an undetermined amount to establish and maintain this women's facility, as the board currently operates a men's residential transition center.
