House Bill 90 as introduced would increase the obligations of the local boards of education by an estimated \$10,141 annually for each student with an intellectual disability that has not earned an Alabama high school diploma by age 21 and remains in school until age 26 as provided by this bill. According to the State Department of Education, there were 1,253 students statewide that received special education services and did not receive a high school diploma, for fiscal year 2020.
