House Bill 72 as reported by the Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security could increase the obligations of the Department of Corrections by an estimated \$28 for each day a parolee remains in a county jail past the 20 business day window provided by current law, due to a delay in holding a parole violation hearing as provided by this bill.
