Senate Bill 320 as reported by the Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security could increase the obligations of the Department of Forensic Sciences, paid from the DNA Database Fund, by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost to test and catalog DNA samples taken from illegal aliens in the custody of local law enforcement agencies.

In addition, this bill could increase the administrative obligations of the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency to catalog fingerprints of illegal aliens.

This bill could also increase the obligations of local law enforcement agencies by an undetermined amount to collect DNA and fingerprints of illegal aliens in the custody of the agency.

Finally, this bill would increase receipts to the DNA Database Fund, assessed in certain cases, by increasing the court fee from \$11, under current law, to \$14, beginning in fiscal year 2024.
