## House Bill 489

**House Bill 489** as introduced would increase the administrative obligations of: (1) each local board of education by preventing students from accessing social media on school-provided internet and by requiring students entering ninth-grade to complete one semester of instruction on the use of social media; and (2) the State Board of Education by requiring the adoption of rules to implement the provisions of this bill, beginning with the 2024-2025 school year.

This bill will also increase the administrative obligations of the State Department of Education and the local boards of education by requiring each entity to publish curriculum material on their respective websites, and for the local board of education to inform parents how to access the material.
