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10	Relating to natural resources; to require the
11	Commissioner of the Department of Conservation and Natural
12	Resources to issue a permit for the introduction of black bass
13	into the Coosa River in certain circumstances.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. (a) The Commissioner of the Department of
16	Conservation and Natural Resources shall issue a permit to a
17	municipality or private entity associated with fishing or
18	conservation allowing the introduction and placement of black
19	bass into the Coosa River if all of the following are
20	satisfied:
21	(1) The municipality or private entity obtains the
22	black bass from a fish hatchery located in this state that is
23	approved by the department.
24	(2) The only black bass being introduced or placed into
25	the Coosa River are the Northern Largemouth Bass (Micropterus
26	salmoides salmoides) subspecies, the Florida Bass (Micropterus
27	salmoides floridanus) subspecies, or a first generation
28	offspring of these two subspecies.



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- 29 (3) The municipality or private entity bears all costs 30 associated with the purchase, transport, and introduction of 31 black bass.
- 32 (b) The commissioner, under his or her authority
  33 granted in Section 9-2-2 and 9-2-7, Code of Alabama 1975, may
  34 deny a permit for the introduction and placement of black bass
  35 into the Coosa River due to environmental, pathogenic, or
  36 biological factors or for the protection of public health and
  37 welfare.
- 38 (c) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the
  39 commissioner from issuing permits for the introduction and
  40 placement of other subspecies of black bass into segments of
  41 the Coosa River when the commissioner determines that the
  42 introduction and placement of those subspecies is appropriate
  43 for the fishery.
- (d) The Department of Conservation and Natural
  Resources shall adopt rules as necessary to implement this
  section.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
