In case of a 32 warrantless arrest, the director or employee shall prepare a 33 written warrant stating that the offender, in his or her 34 judgment, has committed a criminal offense or violated a 35 condition of supervision, and the warrant shall suffice to 36 immediately bring the offender before the court to determine 37 probable cause for the act described in the warrant. The court may order detention of the offender pending further hearing, 38 39 after which the court may revoke probation or participation in the authority's community corrections program, or both, 40 pursuant to subdivision (d)(3) of Section 15-18-175, Code of 41 Alabama 1975. 42 43 (c) The director and employees of the authority given 44
 - (c) The director and employees of the authority given powers of arrest by this section shall be required to comply with the minimum standards for state law enforcement officers as certified by the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission.
