4	This bill would propose an amendment to the
5	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to Shelby
6	County, that would allow county commissioners in the
7	county to participate in the Employees' Retirement

15	This bill would propose an amendment to the
16	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to Shelby County, to
17	allow county commissioners in the county to participate in the
18	Employees' Retirement System under certain conditions.
19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
21	of Alabama of 2022, is proposed and shall become valid as a
22	part of the constitution when all requirements of this act are
23	fulfilled:
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25	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
26	Section 58-8.00 of the Constitution of Alabama of
27	2022, is amended to read as follows:

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"§58-8.00

OF ALARTHA

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29	No elected or appointed Shelby County official or
30	sheriff may assume a supernumerary office after the effective
31	date of this amendment. Any person who, on the effective date
32	of this amendment, is entitled to participate in a
33	supernumerary program may continue to participate in that
34	supernumerary program, which shall include the assumption of a
35	supernumerary office according to the terms and conditions of
36	the law which established that supernumerary program. Every
37	elected or appointed Shelby County official may participate in
38	the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama upon the same
39	terms and conditions as may be specified by law for any other
40	employee in the same retirement system, and shall be treated
41	as an employee of the county. Shelby County officials holding
42	office at the time of the ratification of this amendment shall
43	be eligible to purchase service credit in the Employees'
44	Retirement System for the time the official has served in the
45	current office. No person may participate in both a
46	supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement System
47	based on the same service. For the purposes of this amendment,
48	the words "elected or appointed Shelby County official" shall
49	include any person appointed to serve the remaining term of an
50	elected or appointed Shelby County official. The words do not
51	include a judge, county commissioner, district attorney,
52	legislator, constable, school board member, or any official
53	elected from a judicial circuit. Any Shelby County
54	Commissioner holding office as a member of the Shelby County
55	Commission at the time of ratification of the amendment of
56	this amendment shall be eligible to purchase service credit in

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57	the Employees' Retirement System for the time the official has
58	served in the current office."
59	Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the
60	Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as
61	appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional
62	paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:
63	change capitalization, spelling, and punctuation for purposes
64	of style and uniformity; correct manifest grammatical,
65	clerical, and typographical errors; and correct incorrect
66	cross-references.
67	Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
68	shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 284.01 of
69	the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of
70	this state.
71	Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
72	assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
73	amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
74	following description of the substance or subject matter of
75	the proposed constitutional amendment:
76	"Relating to Shelby County, proposing an amendment to
77	the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to allow county
78	commissioners in the county to participate in the Employees'
79	Retirement System under certain conditions.
80	"Proposed by Act"
81	This description shall be followed by the following
82	language:
