12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. This act shall only apply to St. Clair
14	County.
15	Section 2. After the effective date of this act, any
16	person qualifying for election to the office of sheriff or any
17	person appointed to serve as sheriff, in addition to any other
18	qualifications required by law, shall meet all of the
19	following qualifications:
20	(1) The person is a citizen of the United States.
21	(2) The person has been a resident of the county for at
22	least one year before the qualification date or being
23	appointed to the office.
24	(3) The person has been awarded a high school diploma
25	or GED equivalence.
26	(4) The person is 30 years of age or older.
27	(5) The person has at least five years of experience as
28	a full-time law enforcement officer as certified by the



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29	Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission.
30	(6) The person has never been convicted of a felony.
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32	Section 3. Upon election or appointment, the sheriff
33	shall annually attend a minimum of 12 hours of executive level
34	continuing education approved by the Alabama Sheriffs
35	Association or the National Sheriffs' Association. Proof of
36	attendance shall be filed with the judge of probate of the
37	county by December 31 of each year.
38	Section 4. This act shall become effective on the first
39	day of the third month following its passage and approval by
40	the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
