18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
19	Section 1. The parent or guardian of a student at a
20	public K-12 school shall have the right to opt his or her
21	child out of any order or requirement that students wear a
22	face covering at the school, at a school function, on a school
23	bus, or at a school bus stop, by communicating his or her
24	intent to opt out in writing to the school or the local board
25	of education.
26	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
27	day of the third month following its passage and approval by

the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
