SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, termination dates are established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset Committee. After the review process is completed, the committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which either continue, terminate, or continue with modification each agency reviewed.

This bill would provide for the continuance of the Polygraph Examiners Board.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the existence and functioning of the Polygraph Examiners Board until October 1, 2027.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Polygraph Examiners Board until October 1, 2027.

Section 2. The existence and functioning of the

29 Polygraph Examiners Board, created and functioning pursuant to  
30 Sections 34-25-1 to 34-25-36, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975,  
31 is continued until October 1, 2027, and those code sections  
32 are expressly preserved.

33 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the  
34 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
35 Sections 1 and 2.

36 Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately  
37 upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its  
38 otherwise becoming a law.
