SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, all motor vehicle license plate designs are valid for a period of five years.

This bill would make all motor vehicle license plate designs valid for a period of 10 years.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to motor vehicle licenses and registration; to amend Section 32-6-62, Code of Alabama 1975, to extend the validity period of motor vehicle license plate designs from five years to 10 years.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 32-6-62, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§32-6-62

(a) Subject to subsection (b), all motor vehicle license plate designs shall be valid for not less than ~~five~~10 years. The Commissioner of Revenue, with the approval of the License Plates Legislative Oversight Committee established by Section 32-6-67, may authorize a license plate design to be valid for more than ~~five~~10 years.

29 (b) Subsection (a) shall not affect any law which
30 designates a license plate design to be permanent."

31 Section 2. This act shall become effective January 1,
32 2024, following its passage and approval by the Governor, or
33 its otherwise becoming law.
