5	Under existing law, all motor vehicle license
6	plate designs are valid for a period of five years.
7	This bill would make all motor vehicle license
8	plate designs valid for a period of 10 years.

15	Relating to motor vehicle licenses and registration; to
16	amend Section 32-6-62, Code of Alabama 1975, to extend the
17	validity period of motor vehicle license plate designs from
18	five years to 10 years.
19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. Section 32-6-62, Code of Alabama 1975, is
21	amended to read as follows:
22	"\$32-6-62
23	(a) Subject to subsection (b), all motor vehicle
24	license plate designs shall be valid for not less than $\frac{five}{10}$
25	years. The Commissioner of Revenue, with the approval of the
26	License Plates Legislative Oversight Committee established by
27	Section 32-6-67, may authorize a license plate design to be
28	valid for more than <u>five10</u> years.

(b) Subsection (a) shall not affect any law which
designates a license plate design to be permanent."
Section 2. This act shall become effective January 1,
