13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. This act is adopted pursuant to the
15	authority in subdivision (31) of Section 104 of the
16	Constitution of Alabama of 2022.
17	Section 2. (a) The City Council of the City of Calera,
18	by ordinance, may provide for the establishment of not more
19	than two entertainment districts in the city, as those
20	districts are defined in the Calera City Code. The
21	entertainment districts may contain one or more Alcoholic
22	Beverage Control Board licensees in an area that does not
23	exceed one-half mile by one-half mile. The ordinance of the
24	city council shall regulate hours of operation of an
25	entertainment district, may provide for the revocation of the
26	entertainment district designation, and may regulate any other
27	aspect of the operation of entertainment districts.

- 29 Beverage Control Board licensed to sell alcoholic beverages 30 for on-premises consumption located in an entertainment 31 district may obtain an entertainment district permit. 32 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any licensee that 33 receives an entertainment district permit shall comply with 34 all laws and rules governing its license, except that patrons, 35 quests, or members of the licensee may exit the licensed 36 premises with open containers of alcoholic beverages anywhere 37 within the confines of the entertainment district, but may not enter the premises of another licensee with open containers or 38 39 closed containers of alcoholic beverages acquired elsewhere. In addition, the ordinance shall prohibit a person other than 40 a retail licensee from possessing or bringing in the 41 42 entertainment district an open or closed container of 43 alcoholic beverages acquired outside of the entertainment district during the hours of operation of the entertainment 44 45 district.
- 46 (c) The ordinance of the city council shall be enforced 47 by the City of Calera and shall provide penalties for 48 violations of the ordinance as otherwise authorized by law.
- Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.
- Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
