36	his or her appointee.
37	(7) An additional member chosen by the other voting
38	members of the board.
39	(8) The mayor or his or her designee of any other
40	municipality in Lee County that contains an entity that is
41	required to pay a lodging tax.
42	(9) The Lee County Extension Agent, who shall be an
43	ex-officio membera non-voting member. The Executive Director
44	of the Auburn Chamber of Commerce and the Executive Director
45	of the Opelika Chamber of Commerce shall serve as ex-officio
46	members.
47	(10) Two non-voting members appointed by the voting
48	members of the board from the local tourism industry.
49	(b) (c) The newly elected board of directors' membership
50	Each appointed member of the board shall serve at the pleasure
51	of the his or her appointing authorities authority."
52	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
