9	Relating to Montgomery County; to amend Section
10	45-51-231 of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to an expense
11	allowance and salary of the sheriff, to restate the current
12	salary of the sheriff and to delete an expired expense
13	allowance; and to provide a new expense allowance for the
14	sheriff and for the salary of the sheriff if the sheriff has
15	served two or more full consecutive terms as sheriff.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. Section 45-51-231 of the Code of Alabama
19	1975, is amended to read as follows:
20	"\$45-51-231
21	(a) The Sheriff of Montgomery County shall receive an
22	expense allowance of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) per
23	year, payable in equal monthly installments from the general
24	fund of the county. This expense allowance shall be in
25	addition to all other compensation or benefits granted to the
26	sheriff and may be treated as compensation for retirement
27	contributions.
28	(b) Effective beginning the next term of office,

29 theExcept as provided in Section 2 of the act adding this
30 language, the annual salary of the Sheriff of Montgomery
31 County shall be one hundred fifty-five thousand dollars
32 (\$155,000) and the expense allowance provided for in
33 subsection (a) shall become null and void.
34 Section 2. (a) (1) Any Sheriff of Montgomery County who

has served two consecutive full terms shall receive an additional expense allowance of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) per year, payable in equal monthly installments from the general fund of the county. This expense allowance shall be in addition to all other compensation or benefits granted to the sheriff and may be treated as compensation for retirement contributions.

42 (2) This subsection shall be void at the end of the
43 current term of the sheriff or on a vacancy in the office of
44 sheriff for any reason.

(b) Effective beginning the next term of office of the Sheriff of Montgomery County, and thereafter, any sheriff who has served two or more consecutive full terms as sheriff, shall receive an annual salary in the amount of one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000). The salary shall be paid from the general fund of the county.

51 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first 52 day of the third month following its passage and approval by 53 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
