1 Enrolled, An Act,

4 Relating to Lamar County; to authorize the Judge of  
5 Probate of Lamar County to set and collect a mail fee for the  
6 renewal of motor vehicle license registrations and business  
7 licenses by mail or through the Internet.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. The Judge of Probate of Lamar County may set  
10 and collect a mail fee from any person renewing a motor  
11 vehicle registration or business license by mail or over the  
12 Internet to offset the costs of the renewal, including the  
13 costs of the mailing of the motor vehicle license decals or  
14 license plates or the renewed business license to the person  
15 renewing the registration or license. The judge of probate may  
16 set the mail fee on each transaction not to exceed five  
17 dollars (\$5). All fees authorized under this section shall be  
18 collected and deposited in a special fund in the county  
19 treasury and used at the discretion of the judge of probate  
20 for the operation of the office of the judge of probate.

21 Section 2. The provisions of this act are supplemental  
22 to any other authority or fees of the judge of probate. This  
23 act shall not affect the option of any person to renew the  
24 registration of a motor vehicle or business license in person  
25 in the office of the judge of probate.

26 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first  
27 day of the third month following its passage and approval by  
28 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
