13	TO BE ENTITLED
14	AN ACT
15	
16	Relating to education; to require a public K-12 school
17	or a local board of education to accept certain forms of
18	payment for admission to certain school-sponsored events.
19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. A public K-12 school or a local board of
21	education shall accept cash as a form of payment along with
22	any other form of payment of its choosing for admission to
23	school-sponsored sporting events that are open to the public.
24	Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately
25	following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
26	otherwise becoming law.
