A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To make supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, from the Opioid Treatment and Abatement Fund to the entities and for the purposes herein in the amount of \$10,000,000.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the Opioid Treatment and Abatement Fund the sum of \$10,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, to the entities and for the purposes specified herein.

(1) To the Department of Corrections for opioid and co-occurring substance abuse treatment, including Residential Substance Abuse treatment, FDA-approved medication, and pre and post-release services to justice-involved individuals, \$1,500,000.

(2) To the Department of Mental Health to establish a competitive grant program for community providers that provide opioid prevention, treatment, medication, and services to individuals and families that have a proven positive outcome on individuals and families suffering from opioid addiction, \$8,500,000.

29 Section 2. All funds appropriated in this act not
30 expended in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, shall
31 not revert, but shall be carried forward for the purpose
32 appropriated.

33 Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately
34 upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
35 otherwise becoming law.
