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SYNOPSIS:

This bill makes supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, from the Opioid Treatment and Abatement Fund to the entities and for the purposes specified herein in the amount of \$10,000,000.

AN ACT

To make supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, from the Opioid Treatment and Abatement Fund to the entities and for the purposes herein in the amount of \$10,000,000.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the Opioid Treatment and Abatement Fund the sum of \$10,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, to the entities and for the purposes specified herein.

(1) To the Department of Corrections for opioid and co-occurring substance abuse treatment, including Residential Substance Abuse treatment, FDA-approved medication, and pre and post-release services to justice-involved individuals,

30 (2) To the Department of Mental Health to establish a
31 competitive grant program for community providers that provide
32 opioid treatment, medication, and services to individuals and
33 families that have a proven positive outcome on individuals
34 and families suffering from opioid addiction, \$8,500,000.

35 Section 2. All funds appropriated in this act not
36 expended in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, shall
37 not revert, but shall be carried forward for the purpose
38 appropriated.

39 Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately
40 upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
41 otherwise becoming law.
