
## HB483 Enrolled



1 Enrolled, An Act,

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- 3 Relating to Baldwin County; to amend Section
- 4 45-2-244.134, Code of Alabama 1975, to require that a portion
- 5 of the local tobacco tax be used to establish and maintain a
- 6 sexual assault nurse examiner program; and to make
- 7 nonsubstantive, technical revisions to update the existing
- 8 code language to current style.
- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 10 Section 1. Section 45-2-244-134, Code of Alabama 1975,
- 11 is amended to read as follows:
- 12 "\$45-2-244.134
- The proceeds from the tax authorized, less the amount
- or percentage of the actual cost of collection as may be
- agreed upon by the Commissioner of the Department of Revenue
- 16 and the Baldwin County Commission, shall be distributed to the
- 17 Baldwin County Commission to be allocated on an annual basis
- 18 for the remainder of the 2005 fiscal year, and for each fiscal
- 19 <del>year thereafter,</del> as follows:
- 20 (1) The first eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) of the
- 21 funds or portion thereof received pursuant to this subpart
- 22 shall be equally divided among the following rescue squads:
- 23 Lower Alabama Search and Rescue, Inc., North Baldwin Sheriff's
- 24 Search and Rescue, Inc., and Daphne Search and Rescue, Inc.
- 25 Any additional search and rescue squad authorized by the
- 26 county commission after May 13, 2005, shall be funded out of
- 27 the county treasury in an amount equal to the amount that each
- 28 squad existing on September 26, 2003, receives from the





29	tobacco tax. Each of the recipient rescue squads shall be a		
30	Baldwin County recognized quasi-public entity, as defined in		
31	Section $45-2-140.21$ $45-2-142.01$ , and a member in good standing		
32	with the Alabama Association of Rescue Squads, Inc.		
33	Notwithstanding the foregoing, any rescue squad receiving ad		
34	valorem tax funds pursuant to Section $45-2-242_{7}$ shall be		
35	excluded from the distribution in this section regardless of		
36	the other requirements being met. Provided, however, after		
37	five years from September 26, 2003, the county commission may		
38	equally distribute funds received to any additional certified		
39	rescue squad established after September 26, 2003.		
40	(2) The next forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) of the		
41	funds or portion thereof received pursuant to this subpart		
42	shall be distributed to the Baldwin Abuse Network,		
43	Incorporated, a nonprofit corporation/Southwest Alabama Abuse		
44	Network, or successor thereto office of the District Attorney		
45	of Baldwin County for the creation and maintenance of a sexual		
46	assault nurse examiner program.		
47	(3) The remainder of the funds received pursuant to		
48	this subpart shall be distributed to the office of the		
49	District Attorney of Baldwin County."		
50	Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately		
51	following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its		
52	otherwise becoming law.
