SYNOPSIS:

The Alabama Women's Tribute Statue Commission was established to fund, commission, and place statues of Rosa Parks and Helen Keller on the grounds of the Capitol.

This bill would exempt the commission from the public works competitive bid laws for purposes of procuring the statues.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Women's Tribute Statue Commission; to add Section 41-9-338.4, Code of Alabama 1975, to exempt the commission from the public works competitive bid laws.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 41-9-338.4 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

§41-9-338.4

The Alabama Women's Tribute Statue Commission is exempt from Chapter 2 of Title 39 for the purpose of procuring any contract to commission the creation and placement of statues

33 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first  
34 day of the third month following its passage and approval by  
35 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
