| 5 | An act passed in 2016 removed the original |
| 6 | requirement in the Alabama Brewpub Act that brewpub |
| 7 | locations be confined to historic buildings, registered |
| 8 | historic districts, or economically distressed areas. |
| 9 | However, there remained in the law an inconsistency in |
| 10 | a definition. |
| 11 | This bill would remove the definition of |
| 12 | "premises" that restricts brewpubs to historic |
| 13 | buildings, registered historic districts, or |
| 14 | economically distressed areas in order to conform to |
| 15 | existing law. |
| 16 | This bill would also make nonsubstantive, |
| 17 | technical revisions to update the code language to |
| 18 | current style. |

30 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

31 Section 1. Section 28-4A-2, Code of Alabama 1975, is 32 amended to read as follows:

33 "§28-4A-2

34 (a) The words and phrases used in this chapter shall
35 have the meanings ascribed to them in Section 28-3-1, and any
36 acts amendatory thereof, supplementary thereto or substituted
37 therefor.

38 (b) The following words or phrases, whenever they 39 appear in this chapter, unless the context clearly indicates 40 otherwise, shall have the meaning ascribed to them in this 41 subsection:

42 (1) <u>As used in this chapter</u>, <u>BREWPUB. Any</u> "brewpub" 43 <u>means any</u> premises upon which beer is actively and 44 continuously manufactured or brewed, subject to the barrel 45 production limitation prescribed in this chapter, for 46 consumption on the premises where manufactured, or for sale to 47 any designated wholesaler licensee for resale to retail 48 licensees.

49 (2) PREMISES. Any building, structure or portion 50 thereof designated as a historic building and site as defined in Section 40-8-1, or located in a registered historic 51 district or located in any economically distressed area 52 53 designated as suitable by the municipal or county governing body, in which is located the operations of a brewpub." 54 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 55 56 first day of the third month following its passage and



57 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
