1 Enrolled, An Act,

2

3 Relating to Marion County; to amend Sections 45-47-230
4 and 45-47-242.21, Code of Alabama 1975, to abolish certain
5 expense allowances paid to certain county officials; to revise
6 the salaries of the sheriff, revenue commissioner, and members
7 of the county commission; and to repeal Section 45-47-70, Code
8 of Alabama 1975, relating to expense allowances paid to
9 members of the Marion County Commission.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Sections 45-47-230 and 45-47-242.21, Code of
12 Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

13 "§45-47-230

14 (a) The County Commission of Marion County is
15 authorized and directed to pay the chief deputy sheriff, each
16 deputy sheriff, and the sheriff's clerk an additional expense
17 allowance of one hundred dollars (\$100) per month payable from
18 the general fund of the county. The expense allowance shall be
19 in addition to all compensation or allowances heretofore
20 payable to each such officer.

21 (b) ~~The Sheriff of Marion County shall be entitled to~~
22 ~~receive an expense allowance in the amount of five hundred~~
23 ~~dollars (\$500) per month and each~~ Each deputy sheriff of
24 Marion County shall be entitled to receive an expense
25 allowance of fifty dollars (\$50) per month to be paid out of
26 the county general fund. This expense allowance shall be in
27 addition to any and all other compensation, salary, and
28 expense allowances provided for by law. The expense allowance

29 shall be paid out of the General Fund of Marion County."

30 "§45-47-242.21

31 (a) The judge of probate is relieved of all duties and
32 responsibilities relating to the assessment and collection of
33 taxes, commissions, and issuance fees on motor vehicles. The
34 revenue commissioner shall receive the commissions and fees
35 currently allocated to the judge of probate for performing
36 these functions, and those fees and commissions shall be
37 remitted to the county general fund. Reporting and remitting
38 the collections of those fees shall be made by the revenue
39 commissioner or as otherwise required by law.

40 (b) The Revenue Commissioner of Marion County shall
41 perform all duties relating to the issuance of motor vehicle
42 license plates in the county and shall perform all duties
43 relating to the assessment and collection of ad valorem taxes,
44 commissions, fees, or other charges imposed by law on motor
45 vehicles, which have heretofore been performed jointly by the
46 revenue commissioner and the judge of probate.

47 ~~(c) The Revenue Commissioner of Marion County shall be~~
48 ~~compensated an additional five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per~~
49 ~~year, paid in equal monthly installments from the general fund~~
50 ~~of the county, for performing all of the duties relating to~~
51 ~~the assessments, collections, and issuance of motor vehicle~~
52 ~~license plates in Marion County."~~

53 Section 2. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this
54 act, the Sheriff of Marion County shall receive an additional
55 expense allowance in an amount that brings his or her total
56 compensation to eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) per year to

57 be paid out of the county general fund. The expense allowance
58 shall be in addition to any and all other compensation,
59 salary, or expense allowances provided by law.

60 (b) Beginning with the next term of office, the expense
61 allowance provided in subsection (a) shall be void, and the
62 Sheriff of Marion County shall receive a total yearly salary
63 of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000), which shall be in lieu
64 of any other compensation, salary, or expense allowance
65 provided by law for the sheriff for the performance of his or
66 her official duties.

67 Section 3. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this
68 act, the Revenue Commissioner of Marion County shall receive
69 an additional expense allowance in an amount that brings his
70 or her total compensation to seventy-two thousand dollars
71 (\$72,000) per year to be paid out of the county general fund.
72 The expense allowance shall be in addition to any and all
73 other compensation, salary, or expense allowances provided by
74 law.

75 (b) Beginning with the next term of office, the expense
76 allowance provided in subsection (a) shall be void, and the
77 Revenue Commissioner of Marion County shall receive a total
78 yearly salary of seventy-two thousand dollars (\$72,000), which
79 shall be in lieu of any other compensation, salary, or expense
80 allowance provided by law for the revenue commissioner for the
81 performance of his or her official duties. The compensation
82 provided by Section 11-2A-3, Code of Alabama 1975, shall be
83 considered to be included in the total yearly salary.

84 Section 4. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this

85 act, each member of the Marion County Commission shall receive
86 an additional expense allowance in an amount that brings the
87 total compensation of each member to sixty thousand dollars
88 (\$60,000) per year to be paid out of the county general fund.
89 The expense allowance shall be in addition to any and all
90 other compensation, salary, or expense allowances provided by
91 law.

92 (b) Beginning with the next term of office, the expense
93 allowance provided in subsection (a) shall be void, and each
94 member of the Marion County Commission shall receive a total
95 yearly salary of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000), which shall
96 be in lieu of any other compensation, salary, or expense
97 allowance provided by law for the members for the performance
98 of their official duties.

99 Section 5. Section 45-47-70, Code of Alabama 1975,
100 relating to expense allowances paid to members of the Marion
101 County Commission, is repealed.

102 Section 6. This act shall become effective immediately
103 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
104 otherwise becoming law.
