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A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to Montgomery County; to provide for the creation, funding, and operation of the Montgomery County Legislative Delegation Fund and the Montgomery County Legislative Delegation Office.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) The Montgomery County Commission shall create the Montgomery County Legislative Delegation Fund.

(b) The commission shall deposit at least three hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$325,000) into the fund at the beginning of each fiscal year.

(c) The commission shall immediately pay amounts from the fund as the Montgomery County Legislative Delegation may request.

(d) (1) The commission shall employ an office manager and two administrative assistants to assist in the daily management of the office.

(2) In addition to the annual deposit into the fund required by this section, the commission shall be responsible for the wages and benefits of the three office employees.

(3) The three office employees shall be selected with



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29 the advice and consent of the members of the delegation.

30 (4) The three office employees shall report to the  
31 chair of the delegation, and their official duties shall be  
32 limited to support of the members of the delegation and the  
33 delegation office.

34 (e) The delegation shall expend the monies to acquire  
35 equipment, supplies, services, and all other items necessary  
36 to establish, equip, and maintain a legislative office for the  
37 members of the delegation, and may also expend the monies for  
38 other purposes, including grants for allowable public purposes  
39 at the discretion and direction of the delegation.

40 (f) (1) The largest city in Montgomery County shall  
41 provide adequate office space for the Montgomery County  
42 Legislative Delegation Office, including telephone service,  
43 Internet service, electricity, water, and any other necessary  
44 utility services.

45 (2) The office space location shall be selected with  
46 the advice and consent of the members of the delegation.

47 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first  
48 day of the third month following its passage and approval by  
49 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
