5	TO BE ENTITLED
6	AN ACT
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9	Relating to Jefferson County; to amend Section
10	45-37-91.04 of the Code of Alabama 1975, providing for the
11	board of directors of the Greater Birmingham Convention and
12	Visitor's Bureau, to provide for the appointment of an
13	additional member of the board of directors.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. Section 45-37-91.04 of the Code of Alabama
16	1975, is amended to read as follows:
17	"§45-37-91.04
18	(a) The affairs of the bureau shall be managed by a
19	board of directors, called the board, that shall consist of
20	the following:
21	(1) A member of the House of Representatives
22	representing the county chosen by members of the House
23	representing the county.
24	(2) A member of the Senate representing a senatorial
25	district that includes a portion of the county chosen by the
26	Senators representing the senatorial districts that include a
27	portion of the county.
28	(3) An elected official of the largest city in the
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29 county chosen by the governing body of that city. 30 (4) A member of the governing body of the county chosen 31 by that governing body. 32 (5) The Chair of the Board of Directors of the Civic Center Authority, established by Part 1. 33 34 (6) The president of the chamber of commerce. 35 (7) The president of the city motel-hotel association. 36 (8) The person individual representing the 37 classification of the motel-hotel business on the board of directors of the chamber of commerce of directors. 38 39 (9) Four members, called members at large, appointed in 40 the manner prescribed in this part. 41 (b) (1) In the event that another county with area 42 within the metropolitan area of the largest city comes under 43 this part pursuant to Section 45-37-91.03, as amended, by providing funding, the county commission of that county shall 44 45 be entitled to appoint members to the board increasing the 46 total number of directors by two, and the two additional members shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing body. 47 48 (2) One additional member of the board shall be the 49 mayor, or his or her designee, of the city in the county 50 having the second largest population in the county according 51 to the most recent or any subsequent federal decennial census. 52 This member shall participate in the appointment of the 53 directors at large in addition to the eight members of the 54 board designated in subsection (a). (c) The representative, senator, elected official of 55 56 the largest city, and the member of the governing body of the

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57	county shall be elected for terms on the board expiring when
58	their respective terms as elected public officials expire. A
59	person may succeed himself or herself as a director.
60	(d) As used in this section, the term <u>"</u> eight members <u>"</u>
61	is the eight members of the board above designated <u>in</u>
62	subdivisions (1) to (8) of subsection (a). other than the four
63	members at large.
64	(e)(1) The eight members shall number the directorships
65	at large as follows:
66	a. Directorship at large No. 1.
67	b. Directorship at large No. 2.
68	c. Directorship at large No. 3.
69	d. Directorship at large No. 4.
70	(2) The eight members shall appoint the directors at
71	large from qualified electors of the county.
72	(f) As used in this <u>part</u> <u>section</u> , the term <u>"</u> effective
73	date hereof" is the date on which the provision creating the
74	directorships at large becomes applicable to the county. The
75	first terms for the directorships at large shall run from the
76	first day of the calendar month next succeeding the effective
77	date <u>hereof</u> , irrespective of the date on which the directors
78	at large are appointed.
79	(g) The first term of directorship at large No. 1 shall
80	be for one year. The first term for directorship at large No.
81	2 shall be for two years. The first term for directorship at

82 large No. 3 shall be for three years. The first term for83 directorship at large No. 4 shall be for four years.

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(h) After the first terms for directorships at large

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numbered 1, 2, 3, and 4 expire, all subsequent terms shall be terms of four years, the first four-year terms shall commence on the day the first terms for the respective directorships expire.

89 (i) Every <u>personindividual</u> designated, or appointed, as
90 a director shall serve until his or her successor is appointed
91 and qualifies.

92 (j) In the event of a vacancy on the board, the body or 93 persons appointing the director who immediately prior to the 94 vacancy occurring held the directorship becoming vacant shall 95 appoint one to fill the vacancy and serve for the unexpired 96 term.

97 (k) The members of the board shall serve without
98 compensation but may be reimbursed for actual expenses
99 incurred in the performance of their duties for the bureau."

100 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 101 first day of the third month following its passage and 102 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
