13A-6-2; except, that he or she causes the death due to a sudden heat of passion caused by provocation recognized by law, and before a reasonable time for the passion to cool and for reason to reassert itself.



(3) Knowingly Sells, furnishes, gives away, delivers, or distributes a controlled substance in violation of Section 13A-12-211, and the person to whom the controlled substance is sold, furnished, given, delivered, or distributed dies as a proximate result of the use of the controlled

30	construed to apply to a licensed physician engaged in the
31	practice of medicine, a licensed pharmacist engaged in the

34	(b) Manslaughter is a Class B felony."
35	Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose
36	or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of
37	local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements
38	and application under Section 111.05 of the Constitution of
39	Alabama of 2022, because the bill defines a new crime or
40	amends the definition of an existing crime.
41	Section 3. This act shall take effect on the first day
42	of the third month, following its passage and approval by the
43	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
