7	football competition in 1909 and has a rich history,
8	including a NAIA National Championship in 1968 and a NCAA
9	Division II National Champions in 1984 and 1987, ultimately
10	ascending to the highest level of NCAA competition, Division
11	I-A (FBS), in 2001; and
12	WHEREAS, the 2022 Troy University football team,
13	coached by Mr. Jon Sumrall, won its record seventh Sun Belt
14	Conference football title and compiled the most successful
15	record at the FBS level in program history, with a 12-2
16	record, including a 10-9 win over Army in Troy in the
17	University's annual military appreciation game; and
