4	(RETIRED) DR. RICHARD GOODWIN.

6	WHEREAS, it is with profound sadness that we note the
7	death on March 30, 2023, of Lieutenant Colonel (Retired) Dr.
8	Richard "Doc" Goodwin of Huntsville, Alabama, at the age of
9	74 years; and
10	WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of
11	his loving family, many friends, and the entire community
12	where he was highly regarded; and
13	WHEREAS, Dr. Goodwin's passion for continued
14	education and community service never waned; he graduated
15	from the United States Military Academy (West Point) in 1971
16	and transferred service to the United States Air Force;
17	later, he taught Physics at West Point and attended the
18	prestigious Air War College in Montgomery, Alabama; he
19	served 20 years in the United States Air Force, retired, and
20	continued his service to his country as a government civil
21	servant working for the Missile Defense Agency (MDA) in
22	Huntsville, Alabama; and
23	WHEREAS, he moved his family to Belgium to work at
24	NATO Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe Headquarters;
25	after his tour ended, he returned to Huntsville to work for
26	the MDA; and
27	WHEREAS, as a teenager, Dr. Goodwin achieved
28	scouting's highest rank, Eagle Scout; and

30	church and was seeking a second doctorate in Theology; he
31	also held Master's Degrees in Systems Management, Nuclear
32	Engineering, and Theology; and a Doctor of Philosophy in

34	WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved wife of 50
35	years, Linda; children, Katie (Pete) and James (Lori);
36	grandchildren, Amelia and Ian; brother, Hugh Goodwin
37	(Marianne); and a host of other relatives and friends; and
