1 Enrolled, An Act, 2 3 4 MOURNING THE DEATH OF FORMER REPRESENTATIVE JOHNNY 5 LAWSON ROBINSON. 6 7 WHEREAS, it is with profound sadness that we note the death on March 17, 2023, of former Representative Johnny 8 9 Lawson Robinson; and 10 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of his loving family, many friends, and the entire community 11 where he was highly regarded; and 12 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Robinson was born on March 22, 1950, in Dawson, Alabama; he was the youngest of three children born 14 15 to Thelma Inez Lawson and Horace Clay Robinson; and 16 WHEREAS, a 1968 graduate of Geraldine High School, he was the youngest Deputy Sheriff in DeKalb County at age 16; 17 he attended Jacksonville State University and earned a 18 19 Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice in 1971; and 20 WHEREAS, Mr. Robinson attended the Birmingham School 21 of Law and graduated in 1984, while working full time at the 22 District Attorney's office; and he was elected to the Alabama State Legislature in 1994 where he served until 2014 23 24 before retiring from public service; and 25 WHEREAS, he formally exonerated the wrongly accused 26 Scottsboro Boys, recruited U.S. Gypsum to Bridgeport, established the Senior Rx program, sponsored the bill that 27 created the James Martin Wildlife area and co-sponsored the 28

29 bill dedicating a section of I-65 as "The Lost Highway"; and 30 WHEREAS, Mr. Robinson was a faithful and dedicated member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church; his favorite Bible 31 32 verse was Luke 12:48, "For everyone to whom much is given, 33 much shall be required; and of him to whom men entrust much, they will require and demand all the more"; and 34 35 WHEREAS, he was preceded in death by his mother, 36 Thelma Inez Robinson, father, Horace Clay Robinson; and 37 brother, Larry Robinson; and 38 WHEREAS, survivors include his son, Lawson Robinson; sister, Annette Robinson and niece, Amy Robinson; and a host 39 of other relatives and friends; and 40 41 WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly 42 missed, the memory of Mr. Robinson will be cherished in the 43 hearts of all who knew and loved him; now therefore; BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 44 45 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the death of former 46 Representative Johnny Lawson Robinson is recorded with deep sadness, and this resolution is offered in tribute to his 47 life and with heartfelt sympathy to his family, whose grief 48 is shared by many. 49
