HJR___ RECOGNIZING THE ALABAMA YOM HASHOAH COMMEMORATION ON
APRIL 18, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Alabama Holocaust Commission will host a
2023 State Yom HaShoah Commemoration on April 18, 2023, to
observe the passage of Yom HaShoah; the Alabama Holocaust
Commission is overjoyed to announce that this year's Yom
HaShoah Commemoration will be held at the Alabama Department
of Archives and History; and

WHEREAS, Yom HaShoah was instituted by Israel in 1951
as a day of commemoration for the six million Jews who
perished in the Holocaust, the largest manifestation of hate
and intolerance in modern history; and

WHEREAS, there is no institutionalized ritual for Yom
HaShoah; commemorations may include synagogue services,
communal vigils, and educational programs; the lighting of
memorial candles and reciting of prayers for the departed
are generally featured in the solemn ceremony; and

WHEREAS, this year's ceremony will include a
broadcast of various speakers, including government
officials, figures from the Alabama Jewish community, and
stories of Holocaust survivors and liberators; and

WHEREAS, at this year's ceremony, the presence of

26 Holocaust survivors who have died within the last year will
27 be dearly missed after decades of sharing their stories and
28 spreading awareness of the horrors they personally witnessed
29 of those who suffered and died during the Holocaust; the
30 ceremony will also commemorate and honor the memory of all
31 victims of the Holocaust, including all living and recently
32 departed Holocaust survivors; and

33 WHEREAS, the Alabama Holocaust Commission was
34 established by legislation in 1999 to foster understanding
35 and promote education about the Holocaust; our good friends
36 and colleagues, Representatives David Faulkner and Danny
37 Garrett, and Senator Jabo Waggoner are all active members of
38 the commission; and

39 WHEREAS, among the duties of the Alabama Holocaust
40 Commission is the responsibility to enhance public awareness
41 of the consequences and significance of the Holocaust; the
42 enabling act of the commission states that it is the policy
43 of the State of Alabama that Holocaust education is the
44 proper concern of all peoples; and

45 WHEREAS, events such as the 2023 Yom HaShoah
46 Commemoration are consistent with the mission of the Alabama
47 Holocaust Commission providing Holocaust education and
48 focusing on citizen involvement in this commemoration; now
