5 WILSON LOCK ON THE TENNESSEE RIVER.

7 WHEREAS, The State of Alabama recognizes the immense impact Wilson Lock has on agriculture, industry, recreation, 8 both interstate and intrastate commerce, the economic 9 interests of the state, and the State of Alabama as a whole; 10 11 the Tennessee River serves the entire northern portion of 12 the state as a vital artery connecting the state to not only 13 the rest of the nation but the entire world as part of the Mississippi River Drainage; the Tennessee River is only made 14 15 navigable by dams such as Wilson Lock and Dam; the many businesses and industries located along the river, including 16 17 the cutting edge aerospace companies that are located in this northern portion of the state, depend upon the 18 19 Tennessee River for the transport of their goods; and

20 WHEREAS, Wilson Lock is currently operating under a 21 temporary guard wall solution, a permanent resolution is 22 needed to restore the lock to normal operations to support 23 the contributions the lock provides to the state; without 24 Wilson Lock being fully operational, the state stands to 25 lose one of its most vital connections to the nation and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURING, That Wilson Lock is of national significance and we lend our support in whatever fashion the state deems appropriate to help in this matter, and we fully stand behind the industries of this state that so heavily depend upon this lock.
