13	Section 1. Sections 6-6-544 and 6-6-570, Code of

Section 2. In any judgment concerning real property under Chapter 6 of Title 35, the judgment shall be recorded in the same manner as provided under Section 6-6-544, Code of Alabama 1975.

53 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first 54 day of the third month following its passage and approval by 55 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
