16	Section 1. Sections 19-3-87 and 35-12-73, Code of
17	Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

19	(a)(1) If at any time it should appearappears to the
20	court, or $\frac{be}{is}$ made known to the court, that any balance has
21	been in the hands of any officer for a period of five years
22	and the same remains unclaimed, it the court may make an order
23	directing the same to be paid into the treasury of said county
24	treasury, and a separate account shall be kept of all such the
25	payments and so designated as to identify identifying each
26	transaction.
27	(b) Any person entitled to recover all or part of any
28	unclaimed amount so paid into the county treasury or any part



29	thereof may recover the amount, without interest, before the

40	unclaimed amount currently held in the county treasury or paid

45	a. Any person's right, title, or interest in or to all
46	unclaimed funds shall be forfeited.
47	b. All right, title, and interest in or to the
48	unclaimed funds shall be vested in the county treasury to be
49	set aside solely for the maintenance, repair, and construction

51	(2) Before any unclaimed funds may be forfeited under
52	subdivision (1), the county shall provide notice of the
53	intended forfeiture, including, at a minimum, a description of

56	part of the unclaimed funds may make a claim. Notice shall be
