- (h) (1) Prior to the certification of any clinical preceptorship, the Alabama Statewide Area Health Education Center Program Office shall conduct a needs assessment of the current number and current need for preceptors in the state and submit a final report of the assessment to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Chairs of the House and Senate Health Committees, and the Chairs of the Senate Finance and Taxation Education and the House Ways and Means Education Committees.

Center Program Office shall report on the condition, performance, and accomplishments of the program to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Chairs of the of the House and Senate Health Committees, and the Chairs of the Senate Finance and Taxation Education and the House Ways and Means Education Committees.

- (3) The Alabama Statewide Area Health Education Center Program Office shall consult with the Alabama Commission on the Evaluation of Services to develop performance metrics and other measures of success to include in the annual report required pursuant to subdivision (2). During the fiscal year 2030, the program shall undergo an evaluation by the Alabama Commission on the Evaluation of Services to determine whether the program is impacting the determined measures of success.
