4 SYNOPSIS:

5 This bill would regulate and prohibit 6 wakeboarding and wakesurfing under certain conditions 7 on the waters of the state impounded by Lewis Smith Dam 8 (Lewis Smith Lake).

9 Section 111.05 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, prohibits a general law whose purpose or effect 10 11 would be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds from becoming effective with regard to a 12 13 local governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 14 vote unless: it comes within one of a number of 15 specified exceptions; it is approved by the affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates funds, or 16 17 provides a local source of revenue, to the entity for 18 the purpose.

The purpose or effect of this bill would be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of the amendment. However, the bill does not require approval of a local governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to become effective because it comes within one of the specified exceptions contained in the amendment.

31	Relating to the waters of the state impounded by Lewis
32	Smith Dam; to regulate and prohibit wakeboarding and
33	wakesurfing under certain conditions; to provide penalties for
34	violations; and in connection therewith would have as its
35	purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
36	expenditure of local funds within the meaning of Section
37	111.05 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022.
38	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
39	Section 1. (a) This section shall apply only to the
40	waters of the state impounded by Lewis Smith Dam (Lewis Smith
41	Lake).
42	(b) For purposes of this section, the following words
43	have the following meanings:
44	(1) MOTORBOAT. A motorized recreational vessel.
45	(2) WAKEBOARDING. Either of the following:
46	a. To use a board with or without foot bindings on
47	which a rider is towed by a motorboat across a wake.
48	b. To operate a motorboat in a manner that creates a
49	wake while towing a person using a board with or without foot
50	bindings to be towed by the motorboat across the boat's wake.
51	(3) WAKESURFING. Either of the following:
52	a. To surf a motorboat's wake, regardless of whether
53	the person is being pulled by a tow rope attached to the
54	motorboat that is producing the wake.
55	b. To operate a motorboat in a manner that creates a
56	wake that is, or is intended to be, surfed by another person.

(c) On the waters of this state impounded by Lewis
Smith Dam (Lewis Smith Lake), a person may not engage in
wakeboarding or wakesurfing under any of the following
conditions:
(1) Between sunset and sunrise.
(2) On any portion of the impounded waters where the
width of the portion is less than 400 feet.

64 (3) Within 200 feet from any shoreline, dock, pier,
65 boathouse, or other structure located on the impounded waters.

66 (4) When not wearing a personal flotation device67 approved by the United States Coast Guard.

(d) (1) On a first violation of this section, a person
shall be guilty of a violation punishable by a fine of not
less than one hundred dollars (\$100).

71 (2) On a second or subsequent violation of this section during a single calendar year, the person shall be guilty of a 72 73 violation and shall be fined not less than two hundred dollars 74 (\$200). In addition, at the discretion of the court, the person shall be subject to the revocation or suspension of his 75 76 or her boater safety certification or vessel operator's 77 certification or vessel operating privileges upon the waters 78 of this state for the duration of the calendar year.

(3) Any prosecution for a violation of this section shall be commenced by a citation issued by a law enforcement officer.

(e) Nothing in this section shall apply to any regatta,
race, trail run, parade, tournament, or exhibition on the
waters of this state impounded by Lewis Smith Dam for which a

85 written marine event application has been submitted to and 86 approved by the Marine Police Division of the Alabama State 87 Law Enforcement Agency.

(f) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency and the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources shall take steps to notify the public of the requirements and prohibitions of this section.

92 (g) Notwithstanding the other provisions of this 93 section, for one year following the effective date of this 94 act, a person who violates this section on a first violation 95 shall receive a written warning of the violation; and on a 96 second or subsequent violation during the calendar year, the 97 violation shall be treated as a first violation under 98 subsection (d).

99 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose 100 or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of 101 local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements 102 and application under Section 111.05 of the Constitution of 103 Alabama of 2022, because the bill defines a new crime or 104 amends the definition of an existing crime.

105 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first 106 day of the third month following its passage and approval by 107 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
