

1 Enrolled, An Act, 2 3 4 Relating to elected county superintendents of 5 education; to remove the requirement that the salary of the superintendent be set before the beginning of the term of 6 7 office; and to provide for a retroactive effective date. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 9 Section 1. Section 16-9-12 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows: 10 11 "\$16-9-12 (a) The county superintendent of education shall devote 12 13 his or her entire time to pubic school business, unless 14 authorized to engage in outside employment by the county board 15 of education. In counties in which the maximum salary of the county superintendent of education is not fixed by law, the 16 county superintendent of education shall receive such 17 18 compensation, including salary and travel expenses, as the 19 county board of education shall direct. In counties where 20 superintendents of education are elected by a direct vote of the qualified electors, the salary for the office must be 21 fixed prior to the beginning of the term of office. 22 23 (b) Commencing on July 1, 2021, in counties where 24 superintendents of education are elected by a direct vote of 25 the qualified electors, the salary for the office is not 26 required to be fixed before the beginning of the term of office." 27

28 Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately
