## SB306 INTRODUCED

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4 SYNOPSIS:

This bill would provide for a chair of the county commission to be elected countywide in any county in which the county commission is currently composed of four county commissioners and the chair of the county commission is currently rotating among these county commissioners. The chair of the county commission would first be elected for a two-year term in 2024 and thereafter for four-year terms commencing in 2026.

Relating to any county in which the county commission is currently composed of four county commissioners and the chair of the county commission is currently rotating among these commissioners; to provide for the election of the chair of the county commission on a countywide basis as an additional member of the commission commencing with the general election in 2024; to provide for terms; and to provide for the salary and duties of the chair of the county commission.

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- 29 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 30 Section 1. Section 11-3-1.3 is added to the Code of

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- 33 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 11-3-1 or 34 any other law to the contrary, in any county in which, on the 35 effective date of this act, the county commission is composed 36 of four county commissioners and the chair rotates among these 37 members of the county commission on a rotating basis, effective at the general election in 2024 and thereafter, the 38 39 chair of the county commission shall be elected countywide as an additional member of the county commission. Upon the 40 election and qualification of chair of the county commission 41 42 pursuant to this section, any provision for the existing 43 members of the county commission to serve on a rotating basis
  - (b) The initial term of the elected chair shall be for two years and a successor shall be elected at the general election in 2026, and every four years thereafter, to serve a term concurrent with the terms of the other four members of the county commission. The term of the chair shall commence in November after the election at the same time provided for members of a county commission.
  - (c) The elected chair of the county commission shall serve on a full-time basis and shall perform all of the duties of a chair of a county commission provided by general law or any local law applicable to the county. The elected chair may vote in any matter coming before the commission.



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57	(d) The elected chair provided for by this section
58	shall receive an annual salary based on the same salary
59	schedule as a circuit judge. The salary schedule shall be
60	applied to the chair in the same manner as the salary schedule
61	is applied to a circuit judge, including any provisions for
62	adjustments based on years of service.

- 63 (e) This section shall not affect the salary or the annual basic compensation of the remaining four members of the 64 65 county commission.
- Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict 66 67 with this act are repealed.
- 68 Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its 69 otherwise becoming law. 70
