4 SYNOPSIS:
5 This bill would require law enforcement agencies
6 to collect fingerprints and DNA from any illegal alien
7 in the agency's custody and submit the fingerprints and
8 DNA for testing or cataloging.

9 Section 111.05 of the Constitution of Alabama of 10 2022, prohibits a general law whose purpose or effect 11 would be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds from becoming effective with regard to a 12 13 local governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 14 vote unless: it comes within one of a number of specified exceptions; it is approved by the affected 15 16 entity, or the Legislature appropriates funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to the entity for 17 18 the purpose.

19 The purpose or effect of this bill would be to 20 require a new or increased expenditure of local funds 21 within the meaning of the amendment. If this bills is 22 not enacted by a 2/3 vote, it will not become effective 23 with regard to a local entity unless approved by the 24 local entity or until, and only as long as, the 25 Legislature appropriates funds or provides for a local source of revenue. 26

34	enforcement agencies to collect fingerprints and DNA from any

37	connection therewith would have as its purpose or effect the
38	requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds
39	within the meaning of Section 111.05 of the Constitution of
40	2022.
41	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
42	Section 1. (a) Whenever a law enforcement agency in
43	this state has an illegal alien in its custody, the law
44	enforcement agency may not release the illegal alien until the
45	law enforcement agency has collected a full set of
46	fingerprints and a DNA sample from the individual.
47	(b) Following the collection of any fingerprints or DNA
48	pursuant to this section, a law enforcement agency shall
49	submit the fingerprints or DNA for testing or cataloging.
50	Section 2. The purpose or effect of this bill would be
51	to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds
52	within the meaning of Section 111.05 of the Constitution of
53	Alabama of 2022. If this bill is not enacted by a $2/3$ vote, it
54	will not become effective with regard to a local entity unless
55	approved by the local entity or until, and only as long as,
56	the Legislature appropriates funds or provides for a local



57 source of revenue.

58 Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately 59 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its 60 otherwise becoming law.
