15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
16	Section 1. Section 45-16-62, Code of Alabama 1975, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	" §45-16-62
19	(a) The coroner shall be elected at the general
20	election and every four years thereafter, and shall serve for
21	a term of four years.
22	(b) The coroner shall appoint a chief deputy coroner
23	from the judicial circuit division of the county where the
24	elected coroner does not reside. The chief deputy coroner
25	shall be entitled to compensation in the amount of four
26	hundred dollars (\$400) per month. The coroner may appoint one
27	deputy coroner. The deputy coroner shall be entitled to
28	compensation in the amount of three hundred dollars (\$300) per

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- 29 month. The Coffee County Commission may adjust the
- 30 compensation and any expense allowance for the chief deputy
- 31 coroner or deputy coroner by resolution of the commission. Any
- 32 compensation or expense allowance shall be paid from the
- 33 county general fund by the county commission.

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- 34 (c)(1) A Coroner of Coffee County who is first elected 35 or appointed on or after September 22, 2015, shall receive an 36 annual base salary of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) 37 per year, which shall be paid in the same manner and at the
- 39 (2) The annual salary provided in subdivision (1) shall 40 continue to be adjusted thereafter as authorized in Chapter 2A 41 of Title 11.
 - (3) If there is a break in continuous service as coroner on or after September 22, 2015, upon reappointment or reelection as coroner, he or she shall receive the base salary as provided in subdivision (1), which may be adjusted as provided in subdivision (2).
 - (d) The coroner may participate in the same retirement system and the same insurance plan in the same manner and upon the same terms and conditions as any other employee of the county.
 - (e) The Coffee County Commission shall pay all expenses incurred or required by the coroner, and chief deputy coroner, and deputy coroner to perform the duties of his or her office, including travel expenses pursuant to state-approved rates for state employees, radio and paging equipment and maintenance costs, and association dues and continuing education expenses.
